Alexej Dmitrenko, Head of Human Resources, and Thomas Peter, Production Manager at Koehler Paper's Kehl site, congratulated the winners and presented them with their certificate and EUR 1,000 prize money at a large awards ceremony on July 29, 2022. The students are free to spend the prize money however they wish.

Alexej Dmitrenko states: “We are delighted to be able to present the award and recognize the graduates’ outstanding achievements. We created the Koehler Paper Award to encourage young people and will now be awarding it to students each semester at Munich University of Applied Sciences.”
